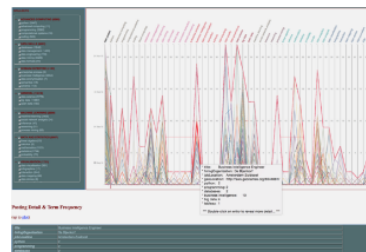
Word Cloud

Browse relative frequency of mention of data science skills in job postings



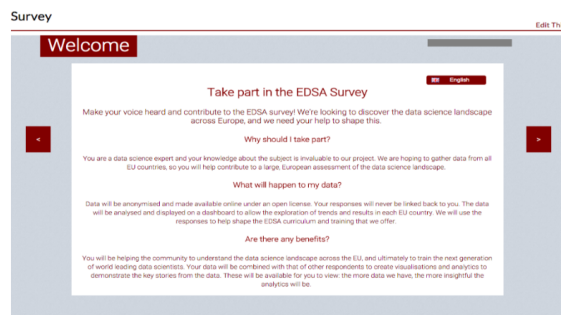
Skill Set Viewer

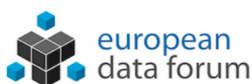
